Basic information about the project

Roma Education Fund Representative office in Serbia implements the project "Employment Empowerment of Young Roma – phase 2" funded by the German Financial Cooperation implemented by KfW on behalf of the German Government – Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development.

Project "Employment Empowerment of Young Roma – phase 2" through its activities provides technical support and strengthens effectiveness of mechanisms established during phase 1, with the aim to combat discrimination and create conditions in which Roma can exercise their rights, with the focus on accessing quality education and labor market and therefore greater employment opportunities.

Project aims are employment empowerment of young Roma by capacity building through wide range of vocational trainings, continued education and internship in the public or private sector, improving the quality and inclusiveness of education system in the Republic of Serbia, and advocating for the social inclusion of Roma.





Project in numbers:

113 secondary schools in 67 municipalities involved in the project

134 mentors engaged in working with 310 secondary school students

177 beneficiaries completed vocational training

92 beneficiaries attended paid internship

8 beneficiaries completed the German language course

8 beneficiaries completed the English language course

33 beneficiaries got employed

162 returnee families in 4 municipalities supported through the project

181 children from returnee families attended additional classes of Serbian language and other school subjects



Planned for the phase 2

200 secondary school teachers will be trained for mentoring support to secondary scholars

Secondary school enrollment campaigns that target 8th grade students will be organized

Vocational trainings, career counseling and paid internship will be provided for more than 500 beneficiaries

Cooperation with public institutions and private companies in the field of education and employment will be continued

Support to educational reintegration of young Roma returnees will be achieved through grant scheme providing funding to local NGOs

Development and delivery of research report and policy paper on the strategic and legal framework in the field of education, employment and reintegration of Roma returnees
